Projects and Initiatives to date

- **YOUTH FORUM** - The Youth Forum was set up for young people aged 11—19 years in Mablethorpe, Truethorpe and Sutton on Sea, so that they could have their voices heard. More recently, the Youth Forum have completed the Harris Boulevard Community Garden, where an unused piece of Town Council land was turned into a Community Garden. The Youth Forum put the design together, held meetings with the residents, presented the plans to the Town Council and made a successful funding application. A lot of positive feedback has been received from this project.
- **HEALTH SUB-GROUP** - The Health Sub Group which is chaired by Janet Goult, Practice Manager Marisco Medical Practice have held a couple of events this year. A drugs amnesty event where £8,000 of unused drugs were returned to the Surgery throughout April and May, and more recently a Dementia Awareness Day on Saturday 9 July where we had 10 information stands with over 80 people attending the event, of which we have had a lot of positive feedback.
- **BEACH HUT OWNERS ASSOCIATION** - The Beach Hut Owners Association was set up by Ann Britz (Beach Hut Co-ordinator) to encourage all owners to maintain their Beach Huts to preserve them for future generations, Members check all huts on a weekly basis. A drop in information session is being organised for all Beach Hut Owners on Saturday 8 October, 10am - 1pm at the Meridale Hall.
- **TRUSTHORPE GARDEN PROJECT** This was initiated by the residents of the Trusthorpe Residents' Forum and the first phase has been successfully completed. A funding bid for the second phase has been approved which includes oak planters along the side of the garden, railway sleepers along the dyke side, a bird table, uplighters and LED lights in the trees.
- **HIGH VIS VESTS** - Funding has been secured for 50 high visibility vests and 30 cones with Neighbourhood Management logo to be used for community litterpicks and events.
- **TRUSTHORPE VILLAGE SIGNS** - Trusthorpe Residents' Forum have secured funding for 3 Village signs for Truethorpe, to help give it an identity. A competition was organised and the winning design was picked by the residents. Each entrance to Truethorpe now has a Village Sign.
- **SUTTON ON SEA PRIDE CAMPAIGN** - Working in partnership with the Meridale Hall, a Sutton on Sea Pride Campaign was arranged on Saturday 16 July which over 50 people attended. They took part in weeding, litter picking and painting. Local businesses also got involved. This will now become an annual event.
- **SUTTON ON SEA VILLAGE SIGNS** - Sutton on Sea Residents' Forum have applied for funding for 2 further signs for Sutton on Sea which will be situated on the A52 entrance to Sutton and Truethorpe Road if the funding is successful.
